Designed for: - Entry-level service technicians in the computer industry.
- Students who want an internationally recognised qualification.

Pre-requisites: Experience of using one or more: Windows XP/Vista/7/8/10.

Objective: To prepare students for the A+ Certification Examinations. (See below) The A+ Certification program is an industry-wide, vendor-neutral program developed and sponsored by the Computing Technology Industry Association (CompTIA).

Course Content:

The course and the examinations cover the following topics:

- the fundamentals of computer technology
- installation and configuration of PCs, laptops and related hardware
- basic networking
- installing and configuring PC operating systems
- configuring common features (e.g. network connectivity and email) for mobile operating systems
- Android and Apple iOS
- security
- safety and environmental issues
- communication and professionalism.

Taking the Examinations:

The exams for the A+ programme can be taken at our centre in Coventry. Both exams must be passed to achieve A+ Certification. The cost of sitting these exams is not included in any fees quoted.
